Margaret Maylin is looking for Members willing to donate towards purchasing planter boxes.


Greg Giannikos has been kept busy ensuring the greens are free from debris and running at an acceptable pace.


# CLUB CHAMPIONSHIP PAIRS


This event is to be played over two days, the <u>18<sup>th</sup> & 19<sup>th</sup></u> of December.



### **TRUE STORY**

On July 20, 1969, as Commander of the Apollo 11 lunar module, Neil Armstrong was the first person to set foot on the moon. His first words after stepping on the moon, "That's one small step for man, one giant leap for mankind" were televised to earth & heard by millions. But just before he re-entered the Lunar module, he made the enigmatic remark "good luck, Mr Gorsky". Many people thought it was a casual remark concerning some rival Soviet Cosmonaut. However, upon checking, there was no Gorsky in either the Russian or American Space programs.

Over the years, many people questioned Armstrong as to what the "Good Luck Mr Gorsky" statement meant, but Armstrong always just smiled.

On July 5<sup>th</sup> 1995, in Florida, while answering questions following a speech, a reporter brought up the twenty-six-year-old question about Mr Gorsky & this time he finally responded because his Mr Gorsky had recently died. Here is the answer to "who is Mr Gorsky?"

In 1938, when Armstrong was a kid in a small mid-western town, he was playing baseball with a friend, in the backyard. His friend hit the ball, which landed in his neighbour's backyard by their bedroom window. His neighbours were Mr & Mrs Gorsky. As he leaned down to pick up the ball, young Armstrong heard Mrs Gorsky shouting at Mr Gorsky, "Sex, you want Sex? You'll get sex when the kid next door walks on the moon!"

Neil Armstrong's family confirmed that this is a true story.
