DID YOU KNOW?



The Liquor Licensing Enforcement Branch of SAPOL are focusing on instances of intoxicated patrons being served alcohol.

Inspectors can turn up at any time and unannounced.

It is an offence to serve a person who is intoxicated and if found to have occurred, the penalties are significant.

The maximum penalty for a first offence is \$20,000.

It is not just the person who serves the drink, it is also every Member of the Board and the bar manager who are responsible.

If you are drinking with someone who has reached the limit, don't encourage them to continue drinking by buying alcoholic drinks for them.

If you are at a venue for the day, pace yourself, have some non-alcoholic drinks during the day.




