Bowls SA have announced a <u>12% increase in capitation</u> <u>fees</u> due to expenses outweighing income. Recent increases in minimum wage and superannuation levy are conributing factors.

The announcement of the new CEO to replace Taryn Sexton is due at the end of July.



PENNANT COMPETITION

What is the Winter pennant?

Ten clubs enter a side of 4 men and 4 women, not necessarily the same people each week.

Matches are played on Friday each week, for 9 weeks. Commencing 29th July and concluding on 22nd September. Play starts at 12.30pm.

The Metropolitan bowls calendar has been published and a copy is on the notice board. You will need a magnifying glass to read it. Irene will put a version up with larger print prior to the beginning of the season.

Pennant Matches commence: Saturday 14th, Wednesday 18th and Thursday 19th of October.

Last Pennant match before Christmas, Wednesday 13th, Thursday 14th and Saturday 16th of December.

Matches will re-commence, Wednesday 10th, Thursday 11th and Saturday 13th of January.

Finals will be played over three weeks with the Grand finals to be played Saturday 23rd, Thursday 28th of March and Wednesday 3rd April.

There will be no Wednesday matches played on 31st January as it is Men's Country Carnival week.

The above dates vary for Premier League as matches are scheduled for some Fridays and Sundays.

The MBA has scheduled the Pennant calendar to be almost complete by Easter, within the busy match programs of Bowls Australia and Bowls SA.

CONSTITUTION REVIEW

As advised at the AGM in May, Bowls SA have issued a model Constitution with a view to all Clubs adopting it prior to the 24-25 season.

Revising our current Constitution against the model Constitution is a mammoth task. The Board of Management has nominated a sub-committee, Grant Devlin, Ian Campbell and Irene Giannikos to undertake the review.

Work on this task has commenced with all the differences identified.

Some clauses/sections of our current Constitution are not included in the model, some are of similar wording and there are some clauses in the model that are not included in our current constitution.

The next step is for the subcommittee to meet and discuss the differences and make recommendations, to the Board.

Once the Board have agreed on the changes, recommendations will be put to the Members at either a Special General Meeting or the next Annual General meeting for the Members to vote on the recommendation/s.

It is hoped to have the review completed within the next few months.




